Anti-Stigma Training Module for Healthcare Professionals in Wales



99% thought the training clarified the role of healthcare professionals in reducing patient stigma.



96% found the content of the training relevant to their job role/workplace.



90% rated the information they received prior to the training as having accurately described the purpose of the training.



99% of attendees rated the trainer's knowledge on the topic as very good/good.



Trainees rated the training **9.4** out of **10**!
